


Which PPRSSA activities did you participate in? (check all that apply) 114 responses

How do you get updates about our league and your team? (check all that apply) 114 responses










- I'm 73 my health has to crap 70



Do feel there was a competitive balance across the teams in your league? (1=No, 5=Yes) 111 responses






- I highly approve of the draft and being able to play with different people rather than having stacked teams every year. 60S, 60F



- "While we celebrated many highlights—such as close games, improved batting averages, and memorable defensive plays—there were also areas where we could further enhance our overall performance and enjoyment. One recurring observation was the need for sharper infield execution, especially during early innings when players were still settling in. Recommendation: Integrating Infield Practice into Pre-Game Workouts To address this and help every player start at their best, I recommend incorporating a focused infield practice segment into our existing pre-game batting practice routines. Currently, the warm-ups emphasize batting and general fielding, but dedicated infield drills could make a significant difference in readiness and confidence.
 - 1. Short Infield Drills: Before batting practice, allocate 10–15 minutes for infielders to work on ground balls, quick throws, and double-play scenarios. This will help sharpen reaction times and reinforce proper fielding techniques.
 - 2. Position-Specific Practice: Rotate players through their regular infield positions to simulate game situations, focusing on communication and coordinated plays.
 - 3. Transition to Batting: Once infield practice is complete, transition to batting and outfield drills as usual. This sequence ensures that all areas are addressed, and players are warmed up for every aspect of the game. **70S**
