To Association Members:

A few housekeeping updates as we seek to keep you informed and work together through this world wide pandemic.

The City of Colorado Springs has issued a notice that ALL events at ALL OF THE CITY'S RECREATIONAL FACILITIES HAVE BEEN SUSPENDED UNTIL AT LEAST MAY 10TH. (See our website for the City's notices)

This coincides with the State Government "Stay at Home" order issued at the end of last week. With these events in mind, your Board of Directors, have extended **the Registration Deadline to Friday April 30th**. Registration is still on a First Come basis. Once a league reaches the maximum number of paid players, additional registering players will be placed on a "Waiting List." **If you have not Registered, get it in ASAP!**

We invite each of you to please check online at our Association Website and find the listing of ALL PLAYERS who have completed the registration process. All registered players' names can be found by clicking on the appropriate "Tab" of the age division/league. If you signed up to play in multiple leagues, you must click on the Tabs for each age division you registered to play in. Once you confirm your personal registration, I ask that you review all the listings for players you are familiar with. If you DON'T find the name of a fellow player, we ask that you extend yourself by making personal contact, to find out the reason this fellow player has not yet signed up. Please send me an email as to the status of an Association member...IF... Current conditions, for whatever reason by this player, prohibit them from participating in our leagues. I GREATLY APPRECIATE YOUR HELP HERE...!!

If you know of anyone who would like to join our Association, please refer them to our website to register for Leagues and Email updates.

We are getting close to the maximum number of players we can accommodate for each league before a "Waiting List" will be created.

With the decision to extend the deadline for player sign up, this also means we will be postponing

Realistically, with ALL THINGS being considered and if we can "flatten the curve" as a Community, as a State, as a Nation, to pull our way up and out of this pandemic, look for sometime in June for our Softball Season to get up and running!
